

ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE: (1) AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 57, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE AND PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTION AND PENALTIES FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT"; AND (2) PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT SEWER SERVICE CHARGES AND SEWER SERVICE CHARGES ON THE TAX ROLL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021

SALSIPUEDES SANITARY DISTRICT

The Board of Directors of the Salsipuedes Sanitary District, Santa Cruz County, California does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That portion of Section 10 of Article II of the Ordinance cited in the title, adopted by this Board on May 17, 1989, as amended from time to time including most recently, by Ordinance No. 101 on June 19, 2019, relating to rates per month for sewer service charges for Residential, Commercial and Institutional connections be, and it is, hereby amended to read as follows:

RATES. Rates per month for sewer service charges are hereby prescribed for each connection to the District's sanitary sewer system as follows:

A. RESIDENTIAL FLAT RATE:

Single-Family Unit Per Dwelling	\$60.83
Multiple-Family Dwelling Per Unit	\$45.62

B. COMMERCIAL; For each 100 cubic feet or portion thereof of water used, subject to a monthly minimum charge equal to the Multiple-Family Dwelling Unit charge:

Bakeries	\$10.51
Restaurants	\$10.51
Laundries	\$ 6.47
All Other	\$ 6.47

C. INSTITUTIONAL: For each 100 cubic feet or portion thereof of water used:

Churches	\$ 6.47
Schools	\$ 6.47
All Other	\$ 6.47

D. FAIRGROUNDS: Per May 2020 Wastewater Revenue Study:

Fairgrounds Monthly	\$ 1,581.34
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All other provisions of said Section 10 of Article II not herein amended shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. The Salsipuedes Sanitary District, Santa Cruz County, California, does hereby elect, pursuant to Sections 5473 and 5473a of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, to have certain charges for services and facilities furnished by it which have become delinquent and the sewer service charges established by said District pursuant to ordinance thereof duly passed and adopted by the Board of Directors of the District, collected on the tax roll of the County of Santa Cruz, State of California, in the manner provided pursuant to Sections 5471 through 5473.11 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California and said ordinance of this District.

Section 3. By previous action, the Board of Directors established Wednesday, June 17, 2020 at the hour of 7:00 p.m., at the regular meeting place of said Board, Salsipuedes Sanitary District Office, 739 East Lake Avenue, Suite 2, Watsonville, California, or if public is still encouraged to observe the "shelter-in-place", pursuant to the provisions of the Governor Newsom's Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20, and participate by teleconference, for a hearing on the sewer service charge report filed with the secretary of this District, pursuant to law, and the secretary has provided mailed notice of the hearing to each property owner within the district's boundaries at least 45 days before the hearing, posted notice of the hearing at three public places in the District, has been placed on the District's public website and has published notice of the

hearing once a week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the date set for said hearing, in the Watsonville Register-Pajaronian, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in said county, there being no newspaper of general circulation printed and published in said District.

Section 4. All other ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall remain in effect, and the rates set forth in Section 1, above, shall remain in effect, until repealed or until superseded by another ordinance modifying the rates charged by this District.

Section 6. Upon adoption, this ordinance shall be entered in full in the minutes of the Sanitary Board and shall be posted for one (1) week in three (3) public places in the District, and shall take effect upon conclusion of the hearing herein held.


